Alumni Committee Discussion

- Need for a new chair and discuss focus for the committee going forward
 - What do institutions do for their TRIO alumni? How can IATP take what programs do? Interview different programs and leveraging that

 - Connecting things that are already happening
 - If we do something, how do we include all TRIO programs, as a TRIO alumni is very different between all the programs.
 - Federal definition involves people who have graduated with a bachelor's degree
 - Reaching out to schools up North for greater representation on the board, Amy will send a request to Scott for a committee chair, possible a co-chair
 - We need to make an Idaho definition of TRIO alumni, and collect data from alumni

Idaho Gives May 1 - 4, 2023

- New fees have not yet been released for 2023. All prices and dates are from 2022 but should give us enough information to determine if we want to participate.
- Costs we will incur to participate in Idaho Gives as well as some anticipated questions and answers.

Registration fee

- \$110 or \$55 if we first join the Idaho Nonprofit Center for \$50
- Only if we register before 3/15
- \$140 / \$80 for registrations between 3/15 – 4/15. No registrations accepted after 4/15.

What if my organization doesn't receive any donations from Idaho Gives?

- As long as you complete the available training, we will refund your registration fee after Idaho Gives concludes.

What percentage of each contribution will my organization receive?

- Your organization has the opportunity to receive 100% of all donations when donors choose to “cover the fees”. In 2022 the standard online fees are 4.5% plus \$.30 per credit card transaction. For ACH transfers the fees are 2% + \$3.00 per transaction.

What are the other fees for Idaho Gives 2022?

- For each donation made, a “Technology and Processing Fee” will be taken out. Here is the breakdown:
 - Payment options
 - Credit card: 2.5% + \$.30 per transaction
 - Plaid/ACH payment: \$100 minimum donations + \$3.00 flat fee.
 - 2% GiveGab fee, capped at \$20 per transaction
 - Total for credit card transactions: 4.5% + \$.30 per transaction
 - Total for Plaid/ACH: 2% + \$3.00 per transaction
- We have worked hard to keep these fees as low as possible. In 2017, the total fees were 6.7%. In 2016 the total fees were 8.9%. Learn more about the true cost of an “offline” donation here. Note: The Idaho Gives platform, GiveGab, makes it VERY easy for donors to cover these fees. In 2020, more than 94.2% of donors covered these fees. Offline donations will still be available to be plugged in. These funds will be added to your organization's total and the Idaho Gives total. It will NOT count towards the Idaho Gives Award Pool prizes.

GiveGab is an online giving platform that helps nonprofits raise money, engage donors, and manage volunteers quickly and efficiently. GiveGab offers a full portfolio of simple and easy-to-use products that allow organizations to function in a more streamlined manner.
